Pray for the Christian children of Japan to be brave enough to worship only Jesus and never bow down to idols.


Pray for Christians to have such joyful hearts that wherever they are - at home, in school or at play - others will want to discover that joy for themselves.




JESUS IS THE LIGHT

A GREAT START

BREAKFAST is one of the most important meals because it helps to give your body a lot of energy for the day ahead. You need lots of energy on a school day. Always ask an adult first before starting to cook and be especially careful when handling anything hot, sharp, or electrical.

YOU NEED:

¹/₂ cup whole almonds, with skins removed 2 ¹/₂ cups of rolled oats Scant ¹/₂ cup sesame seeds Scant ¹/₂ cup sunflower seeds Scant ¹/₂ cup pumpkin seeds 3 tbsp sunflower oil 8 tbsp honey ¹/₂ cup shelled walnuts, roughly broken Heaping ¹/₂ cup of raisins TO SERVE:

Your favorite fresh fruit, such as raspberries, sliced strawberries, bananas, or nectarines. Milk or natural yogurt. DIRECTIONS:

1 Turn the oven on to 275 degrees. Put the almonds, oats, and seeds in a large mixing bowl. 2 Put the oil and honey in a small saucepan and, over medium heat, stir until melted and mixed together. 3 Pour the honey mixture into the mixing bowl and stir well with a wooden spoon, until the nuts, oats, and seeds are coated. 4 Spoon the oat mixture onto 2 baking sheets in an even layer and bake for 15 minutes, then mix in the walnuts. 5 Cook the oat mixture for another 10 minutes, until golden. (The mixture will become crisp as it cools.) 6 Put the cereal in a mixing bowl and stir in the raisins; let cool. Store in the refrigerator until ready to use.

This recipe makes about 10 servings. When you are ready to serve it, pour what you need into a bowl, add fresh fruit, milk or yogurt and enjoy.

MAKE A SNOW STORM

YOU NEED: ADULT HELP!

Baby food jar or any small jar and lid (empty and clean) Plastic snow Small plastic evergreen tree or toy Water Waterproof glue (hot glue)



DIRECTIONS:

- · Glue a small plastic evergreen tree or toy inside lid of the jar.
- · Add some plastic snow to the jar and then fill it with water.
- Put hot glue around the dry inside edge of the lid and screw it on tight.
- Shake the jar. Your snowstorm will come to life.

WINTER STORM Watch or Warning?

Watch: When there is the potential for severe winter weather developing within the next day or so. The storm has not yet arrived, but if it does, it might include heavy snow, blizzards, freezing rain, ice, or sleet.

Warning: When there is severe winter weather occurring or expected. Be alert. Be prepared. If you are thinking of going outside in a heavy snowstorm, don't! Stay inside.


