

In the Old Testament, we read about the children of Israel wandering about in the wilderness. The boys and girls, and mothers and fathers, who lived by Mount Sinai had no church. They had tents for sleeping and food to eat. They had families to love and care for them, but they complained they did not have a special place to talk with God and thank Him for His care.


Moses often climbed up Mount Sinai alone to talk with God about their complaints. God promised to care and protect the Israelites if they promised to obey all His laws. The people agreed to obey, so God instructed Moses to build a Tent Temple.

Moses came down the mountain and told the people that God wanted them to bring gifts for the tent church. What do you think happened next? The answer is in your Bible.

Do you complain about this or that? God has given each of us the gift of TIME. He expects us to be good managers of it. He wants us to be doing good with willing hearts, instead of complaining during bad times. This is called "redeeming the time".



WHAT'S A PROVERB? FILL-IN PUZZLE





Why not give Dad (the BBQ Chef) the day off! Here is an idea where each family member cooks their own meal.

YOU WILL NEED:

- 1 Cut 18" square sheets of heavy-duty foil.
- 2 Choose several meats: chicken, shrimp, kielbasa, hamburger.
- 3 Choose: beans, vegetables, fruit, nuts, and cheese.
- 4 Add: parsley, sliced green onion tops or chives, minced onion.

DIRECTIONS:

Heat your gas grill to 400.

Have each person select a mix of ingredients and place them on one side of a piece of foil.

Fold over the foil and roll up the edges to seal in juices.

Write your name on the packet with permanent marker.

Lay the packets on the grill, close the lid, and cook until the meat is cooked through. The chicken, kielbasa, and hamburger will need about 15 minutes,

the shrimp about 10 minutes. ENJOY!


