I am always inspired when I read Biblical accounts of courageous men and women in the Bible.


May I ask you a question or two? What takes more courage? Building the ark when you have never seen rain (Genesis 6) and your friends are making fun of you or pausing to offer God a prayer of thanksgiving for your food before you eat your lunch at school? Does it take more courage for a young boy to stand before giant Goliath with just a sling and a stone (1 Samuel 17) than it does to keep your eyes on your own test paper when you are not sure of your answer? Young ladies, was it more courageous to protect the spies in Jericho (Joshua 2) or to protect your honor and integrity by always telling the truth? If we are not careful we can be in awe of the courageous actions of other people and miss our opportunities to honor God by making the best choices, no matter what. Remember, it's never wrong to do the right thing and every choice matters.

In Joshua 1, God tells Joshua three times to be strong AND courageous. God will not leave us or forsake us (Joshua 1:5).

children in the Middle East and North Africa have received shoe box gifts


from Operation Christmas Child.....


Pray that the boys and girls who hear the story of Jesus will share what they have learned with their families. Pray that families will join a Church group where they can learn how to share Jesus with others.

COURAGE AND STRENGTH



down, across or diagonal.





Can you find them? The words may go up, down, across or diagonal.



SHADOW PLAY

Are shadows scary to you? Here is a way to make shadows fun! These shadows are called Silhouettes. A silhouette is the image of a person, consisting of the outline with no interior features. The silhouetted person is traditionally cut from thin black card with a white background. See the

examples below.

YOU NEED:

A white bed sheet

A bright light

A chair

A camera (or)







A large sheet of paper (white newsprint type paper)
Something to draw with (thick lead pencil, or crayon)
A sheet of black card stock and white card stock
Scissors and glue

DIRECTIONS:

- 1 Hang the bed sheet across a doorway
- 2 Place a chair behind the sheet facing left.
- 3 Have a person sit in the chair
- 4 Place a bright light on the other side of the chair until you see the side view shadow of the person behind the sheet.
- 5 Pin the white newsprint paper over the shadow on the sheet. Trace just the head and shoulder area. OR...with your camera, you can take a side view picture of the person in front of the sheet. Enlarge a computer print of the picture and cut out just the head and shoulder area.
- 6 Transfer the silhouette to black card stock. Cut it out and glue it to white card stock background.
